ENTRY PROCESS & COMPETITOR PASSES

Entry Criteria

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for Slopestyle and Halfpipe events.

Entries must be submitted to the OC within the mentioned deadline dates.

Australia and New Zealand may enter up to 40 men and 20 women in each competition organised in the other nation.

Maximum 10 (total women and men / maximum 8 per gender)

The Organiser has discretion to accept additional athletes above the quota.

Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license.

The ANC rules are available on the FIS website.

Entries for the FIS Australia New Zealand Premium Cup events can be made by filling out a FIS Entry Form and sending it to Winter Games NZ Park and Pipe Manager Carly Parker at <u>carly@wintergamesnz.kiwi</u>

Participation Fee

\$100 NZD (approx. 55 CHF) per event.

Payment method will be communicated to confirmed teams.

Competitor Day Passes

Lift passes will be provided to all competitors and team officials for official training and competition days and will be distributed at the team captain's meetings. The number of complimentary passes for team officials and support crew will be relative to the team size.

Additional officials and support crew can purchase day passes at the discounted rate of \$84.50/day. To be purchased at the Team Captain's Meetings.









ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Awards

A medal presentation will follow shortly after the final competitor.

The top 3 placing athletes are required to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews immediately after the awards.

Podium winners must wear their competition bib.

Competitor Bibs

Training and competition bibs will be allocated at the first Team Captain's Meeting. All competitors must wear their assigned bibs when training and competing. We kindly ask for these bibs to be returned.

Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted during the event.

Team Captain's Meeting

A full schedule for each TCM will be sent to confirmed teams along with an information pack prior to your arrival. The first meeting will be the night before the first official training day in Wānaka.

Medical Procedure

For all official training and competition days, there will be dedicated medical staff at the top of the course. Provided by Cardrona Alpine Resort, there will be a minimum of 2 ski patrollers who can respond on the course if needed.

There is a medical centre up Cardrona that will advise the next step if need be.

Competition Venue

Cardrona Alpine Resort is an internationally recognized venue with world class course builders and shapers.

Big Bucks Terrain Park has had massive infrastructure upgrades in recent years with approximately 7000m³ earth moved to improve chairlift clearance on the higher features, widening and raising all knuckles and steepening all landings.

Please note Cardrona is a non-smoking mountain and does not permit the use of cigarettes and vapes.

Multi-Day & Season Passes

Outside of the official event days, athletes will need to purchase lift passes directly from Cardrona Alpine Resort.

TRAVEL, LOGISTICS & ACCOMODATION

Visas

New Zealand has a special policy for athletes, coaches, administrators, officials and support staff visiting the country to participate in sporting events. Please check with NZ Immigration to find out if visitors from your country require a visitor visa to enter New Zealand. Information and application forms for visitor visas are available on www.immigration.govt.nz or from New Zealand and Australian Consulates, Embassies or High Commissions.

Liability & Insurance

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Winter Games NZ, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by the athletes, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event. Public Liability Insurance (CHF) 5 million, for the period of the event, is in place.

If you are injured in New Zealand (including whilst competing in a competition), you may need the assistance of the Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC), New Zealand's accident compensation scheme. ACC helps pay for your care – and that means paying towards the cost of your treatment and helping your recovery while you remain in New Zealand. ACC will not cover any medical or related costs arising from the accident after you leave New Zealand. You will accordingly still need to arrange your own travel and medical insurance. New Zealand's medical facilities are not free to visitors except as a result of an accident but even in the case of an accident, surcharges in private facilities will apply.

Air Travel

We recommend that you book your flights as early as possible and fly into Queenstown.

Air New Zealand, Jetstar, Qantas and Virgin Australia are the only airlines that fly directly into Queenstown. However, many other international airlines fly direct into Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch.
