Venue Information

All events at Coronet Peak are free to watch. Lift passes may be required.



Between 9am - 10am on all event days, foot access to the 'Low Spectating Area' can be gained by taking Meadows Learner Express Chair to the top and a gentle walk to the spectator area.

A lift pass is not required. To return back to the base by walking down the big easy next to the wooden fence.

If you are walking on snow, you will need to wear appropriate snow footwear and clothing. Clothing can be hired from Coronet Peak on the mountain -

If you are able to ski/board, the 'High Spectator Area' is great for viewing - our MC will be there keeping you updated.

You will only be able to cross the course at the official crossing points. Please stay behind the fencing in place.

For the safety and comfort of all spectators, large items are not allowed such as deck chairs, umbrellas and tents. Items that you can't fit in a backpack will not be allowed on the lifts.

Coronet Peak provides emergency care & medical treatment for all guests & can arrange referral to other medical facilities for further treatment if required. Ski Patrol monitors on-slope safety constantly & can be approached for assistance at any time.

Anyone receiving treatment will be subject to a surcharge, which is payable on the day.

There are first aid kits throughout the resort & Automated External Defibrillators.

Coronet Peak offers a range of food and beverage options at the Base Building and Heidi's Hut.

Lost and Found Items

Talk to Guest Services will be your first port of call and any items that are found should be turned into staff here too.
