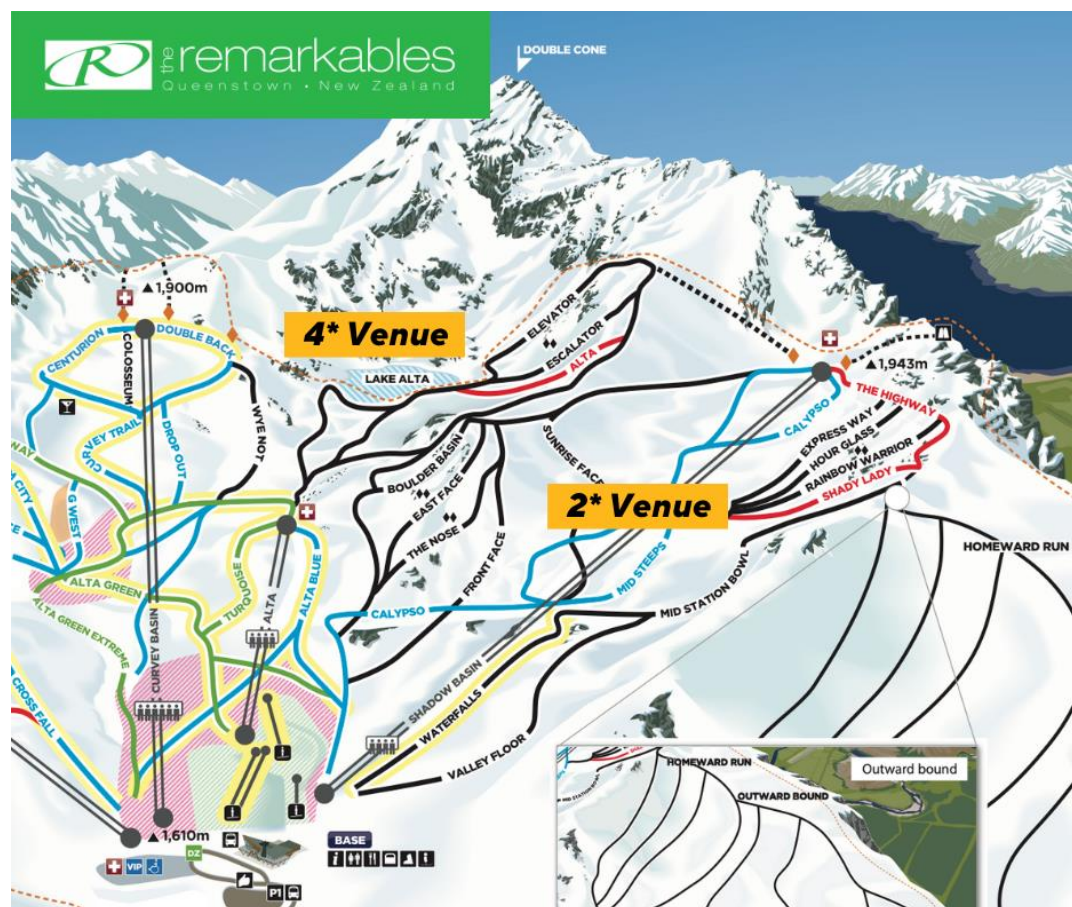

**Venue Information**

All events at The Remarkables are free to watch. NZSki lift passes are required if you are using a chairlift. Standard rates will apply.



The spectator area for the 2\* at The Remarkables is located in the Shadow Basin and the 4\* is located on the Alta Chutes with the spectator area on Lake Alta. It will be a hive of adrenaline with The North Face crew, MCs, Athletes and tunes.

Gaining access to the finish lines is recommended for ski/board only.

2\* - Take the Shadow Basin chairlift to the top and ski the blue run - Calypso.

4\* - Take the Curvey Basin chairlift and for a strong intermediate/advanced ungroomed traverse to Lake Alta.

Walking to the 4\* is an option by snow shoe from the top of the Alta Chair across to Lake Alta.

For the safety and comfort of all spectators, large items are not allowed such as deck chairs, umbrellas and tents. Items that you can't fit in a backpack will not be allowed on the lifts.

The Remarkables is an accessible venue with priority parking areas, accessible toilets in the base area, accessible food and beverage and support for adaptive guests.

### **Medical Facilities**

The Remarkables provides emergency care & medical treatment for all guests & can arrange referral to other medical facilities for further treatment if required. Ski Patrol monitors on-slope safety constantly & can be approached for assistance at any time.

Anyone receiving treatment will be subject to a surcharge, which is payable on the day.

There are first aid kits throughout the resort & Automated External Defibrillators.

Coronet Peak offers a range of food and beverage options at the Base Building and Heidi's Hut.

### **Lost and Found Items**

Talk to Guest Services will be your first port of call and any items that are found should be turned into staff here too.

They are located on the basement level of the Base Building.
